NEXUSBRIDGE "DOMINO NEXUS" EVENT TO BREAK DOMINO TOPPLING WORLD RECORD

Fremont, California, January 14, 2008 - NexusBridge announced today that they are holding a major event on Saturday, February 9, 2008 at 6 PM called "The Domino Nexus", which will combine the start of the Beijing Olympic activities and Chinese New Year. It will encompass a series of locations throughout the Bay Area. With the assistance of many school districts in the Bay Area and China, including Hong Kong, Shanghai and Beijing; high school students plan to break the Guinness Book of World Records for domino toppling. This event will be internationally televised and approximately 5.6 million dominoes will be toppled. The intent of the event is to encourage high school students to bridge closer ties with their peers in the U.S. and China. NexusBridge has advertising and sponsorship opportunities for this and future bridging events.

The following U.S. School Districts involved represent approximately 32,000 students:

The start of "The Domino Nexus" will be held at a site within the Fremont Unified School District, Fremont, California.

Each school district will pick one location to represent their high schools in their district. These districts will be virtually linked by computer in order to topple their portion of the domino chain. Once the last domino is toppled at one location, it will hit a trigger on a computer to send a signal to the next location where another computer will receive the signal and start the domino toppling all over again. Hayward Unified will be the last school district in the chain and will be sending the signal to China to topple their chains which will eventually end in Beijing, China. This event will demonstrate cooperation amongst high school students, educators and administrators working to bridge the two countries together.
